

Your plastics, glass, aluminium and steel recycling service

Most container and bottle packaging can be recycled and need not end up in your garbage bin. You can reduce the volume of waste created in the home simply by recycling as much as you can.

How does this service work?

Single dwellings should have a black container crate for all container recycling and multi unit dwellings should have separate 240L red and yellow bins for container recycling, which are collected weekly. What we can recycle:

- ✓ Glass bottles and jars – clear, green and brown glass only
- ✓ Aluminium and steel cans – all aerosol, food, pet food and beverage cans
- ✓ Plastic bottles and containers marked with recycling symbols



What we don't recycle:

- ✗ Plastic bags
- ✗ Packaging foam/polystyrene
- ✗ Foam meat trays
- ✗ Syringes
- ✗ Plastic plant pots
- ✗ Bottle lids
- ✗ Toys
- ✗ Mirror/window glass
- ✗ Plates/crockery



Be careful not to contaminate your recycling bin or crate. If there is too much contamination, it may increase collection costs for ratepayers and recycling will have to be sent to landfill.
