**2. MATTERS ARISING**

The Cultural Development Coordinator reported that the minutes of the November and February Public Art Advisory Committee meetings were endorsed by Council on 25 February 2008.

**3. WOMEN IN WOOLLAHRA PROJECT**

The application submitted to Arts NSW was unsuccessful. It was suggested that some research occur surrounding the feasibility of endorsing artists who wish to apply for grants program to undertake temporary public art within the Municipality.

**ACTION:** Cultural Development Coordinator to schedule meeting with Arts NSW to discuss future applications.

#### **4. CURRENT PROJECT: PUBLIC DOMAIN IMPROVEMENTS, DOUBLE BAY**

##### **4.1 Update on Expressions of Interest progress including artist feedback**

The Cultural Development Coordinator tabled a list of questions/feedback from artists and design teams regarding the Double Bay Public Art Project and mentioned that there had been considerable interest in the project to date.

##### **4.2 Timeline including Expressions of Interest assessment**

**ACTION:** The Working Party to meet for assessment of Expressions of Interest on Thursday 10 April 2008. Short-listed artists/teams to now be briefed on site on Wednesday 23 April. Cultural Development Coordinator to make necessary changes to the timetable and inform PAAC members.

#### **5. DISCUSSION: CROSS STREET CARPARK**

The Cultural Projects Assistant tabled current global examples of vertical gardens and their benefits. Discussion focussed on systems and their suitability for the climate and area.
