3 PROGRESS REPORTS

3.1 Judges

The judges worked very well together on 7 August, preselection day. The Committee agreed that the day went well and the hospitality component was excellent. The Cultural Development Coordinator relayed feedback from judges commending the preselection process.

The final judging date is Wednesday 9 October at 4pm. Stella Downer has agreed to assisting with placement of works on the morning of 9 October.

3.2 General Project Update

The Cultural Development Coordinator updated that 43 finalists were selected from 634 entries. Free community events have been programmed, with Professor Howard agreeing to host the Artist Talks on 12 October. Although the number of free workshops has been reduced this year, more thoughtful programming has resulted in half of the workshops being facilitated by finalists of the Prize.
