Purpose of the Report:	To provide an update on the planning and coordination of the Woollahra Small Sculpture Prize, 2022.

Resolution:

- A. That the report be received and noted.
- B. That the Woollahra Small Sculpture Prize Committee members vote and return their responses via direct email to <u>Sebastian.goldspink@woollahra.nsw.gov.au</u> with the judges ranked from 1-14; 1 being their most preferred and 14 their least.

Discussion points:

The Committee acknowledged and praised the expertise and skillset of Sebastian Goldspink as the new Art Gallery Coordinator. They were enthusiastic about the upcoming Woollahra Small Sculpture Prize and Sebastian's contribution to it.

- Entries for the Woollahra Small Sculpture Prize 2022 closed on Sunday, 17 July 2022, with 678 applications received both nationally and internationally;
- There's a commitment to notify all applicants of the outcome by the end of August;
- Final judging is scheduled for Tuesday, 11 October. We are anticipating between 50-55 artworks, with the winner to be announced at the official opening on 12 October 2022;
- A tour for the Councillors, Committee members and Sponsors to be coordinated prior to the official opening on 12 October between 5-6pm;
- A media preview is scheduled to take place earlier on the day;
- Artworks to go online at 5.00pm on 12 October;
- Sebastian Goldspink discussed the program highlights and launch activities ranging from weekend artist talks and films, which will be disseminated via the Gallery's social media channels. He indicated that in accordance with sustainable practices, all collateral material will be paperless with an increased presence of QR codes and iPads for voting.

<u>Judges</u>

- Whilst recognised that the proposed three judges were commendable, the Committee felt that it may be beneficial to consider alternative judges, namely Kon Gouriotis OAM, Editor of Artist Profile, and Christopher Hodges, Director of Utopia Art Sydney as proposed by Stella Downer. Other Committee members also proposed alternative judges. The participation of First Nation's voices as part of the judging panel was also discussed by the Committee;
- On 20 July 2022, Sebastian Goldspink will email a proposal list of 14 judges to be considered by the Committee as soon as practicable due to short turnaround for judging time.
