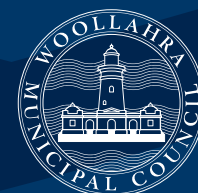


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What can go in my household bins?

Recycling

Yellow lid

Place items loosely
into your recycling bin.
Containers should be empty.

NO PLASTIC BAGS



Plastic bottles
and containers
(lids on or off)



Steel/aluminum
cans and foil
(scrunched into
a ball)



Paper and
cardboard
(including empty
pizza boxes)



Glass bottles
and jars



Aerosol cans
(empty)

Green lid

Place food loosely into
your food and organics bin
or use a compostable bag.*

vegetable scraps



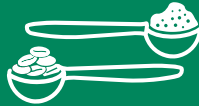
