2019 Woollahra Environmental School Sculpture Prize

Background

The *Woollahra Environmental Schools Sculpture Prize* is open to students from K-12 attending a school in the Woollahra local government area and seeks to engage students with a passion for art and the environment to create a sculpture out of recycled materials that expresses an environmental message.

Theme: Pollinators

Friday 8 November:	Exhibition closes

2019 Judges

Entries will be judged by Council's Environment and Sustainability staff and by a local artist.

About the 2019 Theme

This year's theme encourages students to discover the many different creatures that assist pollination, and explore the importance of pollination for the health of our environment and for our food supply. Animals that are known to be good pollinators include bees, butterflies, birds, moths, some flies, some wasps, and nectar feeding bats. Well-known pollinators found in Woollahra area include honey bees, native Australian bees, the Grey-headed flying fox and birds including the Eastern Spinebill, Rainbow Lorikeet, Red Wattlebird, Crimson Rosella and New Holland Honeyeater as well as many butterflies and other insects.

What do I do now?

1. Read the Conditions of Entry available at www.woollahra.nsw.gov.au/essp
2. Plan your sculpture in line with your environmental message and the theme
3. Start sourcing materials and creating! Don't forget to take pictures of the making of your sculpture for your picture diary and to complete the online Entry Form and Artist Statement before you deliver your sculpture.
4. Hand deliver your sculpture and photo diary (labelled with your unique entry ID code) to Council no later than **4:30pm Monday 21 October 2019**.
