Conditions of entry

Youth Photographic Award & Short Film Prize

Conditions of entry – Photography

- No more than one photography entry per student (or group of students) currently attending school.
- Photographs can be processed and manipulated either in a dark room or digitally.
- Photographs must be the original work of the student.
- Entries can be in colour or black and white.
- All photographs must be submitted in a digital format only. No hard copies.
- Digital format photographs must be a minimum of 2MB or 300dpi.
- Photographs must be submitted via a file sharing service (eg. Dropbox, WeTransfer, Google Drive).
- Entries may be used by Council in promoting the Youth Photographic Award and Short Film Prize and related council activities.

Conditions of entry – Film

- Only one film / animation entry per student (or group of students) currently attending school.
- Films must not exceed 5 minutes in length, inclusive of titles, credits and school to be shown (acknowledging any copyright).

- The film must have been made in the last 18 months and may be produced by more than one person.
- Films entered may be used by Council in promoting the Youth Photographic Award and Short Film Prize and related council activities.
- Films must be submitted as MP4 file on DVD, USB or via file sharing service (eg. Dropbox, WeTransfer, Google Drive). Please note, video files must not be emailed directly.
- Films should preferably be made available online (eg. uploaded to Vimeo or YouTube).

How to enter

- Complete student details spreadsheet (download from woollahra.nsw.gov.au/ypa)
 - Make sure photographs and/or short films are submitted in their correct digital format via file transfer (eg. Dropbox, WeTransfer, Google Drive) or on a USB.
 - Enter online woollahra.nsw.gov.au/ypa
