**Subject:** **Boat and trailer parking in residential streets**  
**Author:** John Stephens, Team Leader - Traffic & Transport  
**File No:** 195.G Pt 15  
**Reason for Report:** Council on 17 May 2004 requested a further report on options to solve the problem of boat and trailer parking in residential streets in the vicinity of Lyne Park, Rose Bay.

**Recommendation:**

A. That alternative parking schemes be referred to the Woollahra Traffic Committee for consideration:

**O'Sullivan Road**

- A 2P Resident Parking Scheme in O'Sullivan Road for the section between New South Head Road and Latimer Road and
- A '1P 10.00am – 12.00pm Sat' parking restriction on the eastern side and '1P 12.00pm – 2.00pm Sun' parking restriction on the western side between Latimer Road and Old South Head Road, or
- A '1P 7.00am – 9.00am Wed' parking restriction on the eastern side and '1P 7.00am – 9.00am Thur' parking restriction on the western side between Latimer Road and Old South Head Road.

**Newcastle Street between Albemarle Avenue & Old South Head Road**

- A '1P 10.00am – 12.00pm Sat' parking restriction on the western side and '1P 12.00pm – 2.00pm Sun' parking restriction on the eastern side, or
- A '1P 7.00am – 9.00am Wed' parking restriction on the western side and '7.00am – 9.00am Thur' parking restriction on the eastern side.

B. That subject to the Traffic Committee's recommendation, the following actions be carried out:

- survey for a 2P Residents' Parking Scheme in O'Sullivan Road between New South Head Road and Latimer Road,
- consult with residents of O'Sullivan Road and Newcastle Street regarding the parking scheme proposal and an alternative scheme incorporating a 1P parking restriction on two successive weekdays,
- report results back to Council with a view to implementing the schemes.

**Subject:** **Woollahra Social Needs Study**

**Reason for Report:** To seek Council endorsement to commence research in relation to the social service needs of the Woollahra community.
