


THE GOETHE-INSTITUT



With the help of the Solar my Suburb program, the Goethe-Institut in Woollahra is showcasing how a heritage building can produce its own locally generated, green energy to power its facilities. The project was supported by a grant from Woollahra Council Community Environmental Grants. Annually, it's estimated the system will:



Save 36% on facility's energy bill





Produce enough power equal to running
4 homes



Reduce carbon emissions by 23 tonnes



Equivalent to taking 8 cars off the road
