



With the help of the Solar my Suburb program, the Goethe-Institut in Woollahra is showcasing how a heritage building can produce its own locally generated, green energy to power its facilities. The project was supported by a grant from Woollahra Council Community Environmental Grants. Annually, it's estimated the system will:

Size of system:	17kW
Estimated bill savings:	\$4,969 each year
Estimated energy savings:	26 MWh / yr
Simple payback:	5 yrs (after funding)
