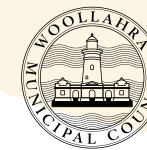

This report outlines progress against our ESAP targets.





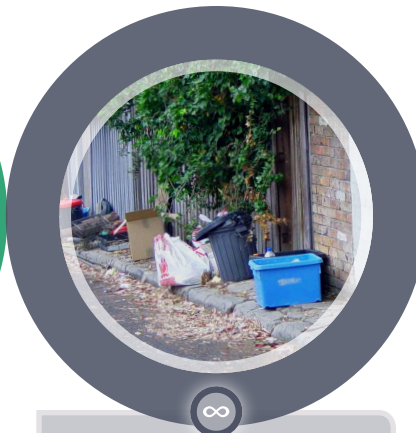

Targets

60kW RENEWABLE ENERGY installed on Council facilities by 2025

30% reduction in greenhouse gas EMISSIONS by 2025

30% reduction in WATER CONSUMPTION on 2004/05 levels by 2025

RAINWATER or **STORMWATER** harvesting systems installed on all major council assets by 2025

60% BUSHLAND under REGENERATION by 2025

40% BUSHLAND FULLY REGENERATED by 2025

URBAN FOREST increases within the next five years.

75% WASTE DIVERSION from landfill by 2022

5% annual increase in waste collected by litter collection devices

30km of roads within the LGA have DESIGNATED BIKE LANES by 2025

2015:16 Status

+ **88kW** of RENEWABLE ENERGY installed

+ **31%** ↓ greenhouse gas EMISSIONS

+ **47%** ↑ in WATER CONSUMPTION compared to 2004-05.

+ **17** RAINWATER tanks installed on Council Assets

+ **3** STORMWATER harvesting schemes installed in Council Parks

+ **70.8%** of Bushland is under regeneration

+ **18.8%** of Bushland is fully regenerated.

+ **245ha** of urban forest across the LGA

+ **46%** of domestic waste was diverted from landfill

+ **41.6** tonnes of waste removed from stormwater drains

+ **24.4km** of BIKE LANES. Some of these are shared bike lanes.
