

Water



30% reduction in WATER CONSUMPTION on 2004/05 levels by: 2017

80% of top 10 water using sites have STORMWATER harvesting systems by: 2025

80% of top 10 water using sites have RAINWATER harvesting systems by: 2025

- 60% Tin WATER CONSUMPTION compared to 2004-05.

The construction of operation of the Kiora Lands centre resulted in a significant increase in consumption.

Waste



66% WASTE DIVERSION from landfill by: 2014

20% increase in HOME COMPOSTING
