Did you know?



- Aluminium is made from bauxite mined from the earth.
- Every tonne of aluminium recycled saves five tonnes of bauxite from being mined.



- Steel and aluminium cans are the least recycled item in our municipality.
- Milk and juice cartons are made from liquid paperboard – a combination of cardboard and thin plastic layers. Recycle all liquid paperboard cartons.



- Bathroom and laundry items like aerosol cans, shampoo, spray and pump bottles are sometimes overlooked. Place them all in your yellow-lid recycling bin.

Recycling Made Easy



Recycling has become even easier with our new yellow-lid, co-mingled recycling bins.

This means all recycling – paper and containers can be mixed into the one bin. No more separating!

Whether you live in a house or a unit, **all your recycling now goes into the yellow-lid recycling bin.**

After collection, all your recycling will be taken to a materials recovery facility to be sorted and bundled by machinery.

Do not put recycling in plastic bags as they tear, get trapped and jam the machinery. Recycling should be placed loosely into your bin.

Return plastic bags back to participating supermarkets for recycling.

Did you know 40% of your garbage is food waste! Reduce it by recycling all your food waste including any scraps, peelings, left overs and spoilt food.

All you need to do is place your food scraps into your green organics bins along with your garden refuse. Together they will be recycled into compost!

YES Place the following items **loosely** into your recycling bin.



Plastic bottles & containers



Steel & aluminium cans



Glass bottles & jars



Paper & cardboard



YES



Garden refuse & food scraps

NO These items do not go into your recycling bin. Contaminated recycling bins cannot be collected.



Plastic bags & cling wrap



Polystyrene & foam



Crockery, window/mirror glass & light globes

NO plastic bags in your green bin please. Place food and garden refuse loosely into your bin.
